Here are the spelling patterns we will be covering in class this half term. We do not set a test weekly as we spend differing amounts of time on the spellings depending on what the children need to consolidate. When we do test, the emphasis is on **improvement.**

Throughout the term we also continue to cover some of the spellings from the Year 3 and 4 statutory spellings list.

Prefix ir-

regular	rational	responsible	resistible	reversible
irregular	irrational	irresponsible	irresistible	irreversible

Prefix il-

legal	legally	legible	literate	logical
illegal	illegally	illegible	illiterate	illogical

We will also look at the Year 3 and 4 statutory spellings

The 'u' sound; when ch sounds like sh

young	touch	blood	trouble	country
does	chef	brochure	parachute	machine

Activities to try with the spellings (these do not need to be handed in):

- Can you write a sentence that uses the spelling correctly?
- What is the longest sentence you can write that includes as many of the week's spellings as possible?
- Could you write a paragraph or mini story using each spelling on the list?
- Have a go at making up a crossword puzzle with the spellings as the answers.
- How many more words can you find that use the root word? e.g. regular → regularly, regulations
- Anagrams: how many words can you make from the letters of the spelling? e.g. illegally: ill, age, ail...
