## **Homophones**

**Possessive apostrophes – singular and plural, e.g The whiskers of one cat = The cat's whiskers; the pyjamas of lots of cats = the cats' pyjamas**

**Contractions – cannot = can't; would have = would've, etc**

Activities to try with the spellings (these do not need to be handed in):

- Can you write a sentence that uses the spelling correctly?
- What is the longest sentence you can write that includes as many of the week's spellings as possible?
- Could you write a paragraph or mini story using each spelling on the list?
- Have a go at making up a crossword puzzle with the spellings as the answers.
- How many more words can you find with the same spelling pattern?
- Which other words can you find that use the root 'scio' meaning 'I know' in Latin? e.g. **science**, **conscience**
- Anagrams: how many words can you make from the letters of the spelling? E.g. delusion: slide, done, does, etc.
