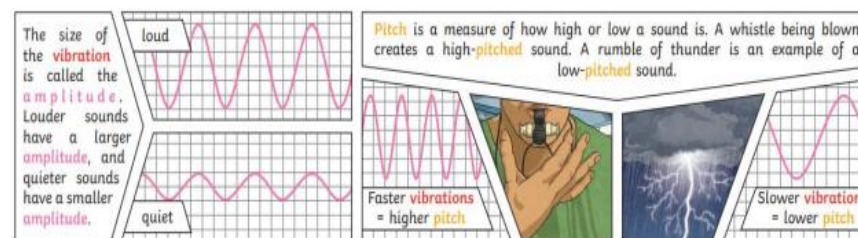

 abstract	Art that doesn't represent images of objects or living things. It uses colour, lines and shapes.	 composition	Putting different elements together in a pleasing way.
 expression	Showing how something sounds or feels by using colours and texture.	 constructing	Using techniques like folding, tying and balancing to join materials together to make art
 form	The shape of something, usually 3-D.	 graphic score	Showing sounds and music with pictures,
 medium	The materials or way art is presented – for example: paint, pencil, clay, film or music	 installation	A construction of mixed media designed for a space.
 texture	The feel or appearance of a surface, substance or sound.	 sculpture	3-dimensional art made by carving, modelling or constructing.
