### 2A Sentences

**2A sentences** have 2 **adjectives** before a noun:

The **glamorous, intelligent** princess kissed the **grotesque, warty** frog.

*2 adjectives must be separated by a comma!*

### BOBS Sentences

**BOBS sentences** contain the conjunctions **but, or, because, so**.

The princess was intelligent, **but** she was ugly.

The princess could kiss the frog, **or** she could leave him for others.

The frog was grotesque, **because** he was so slimy.

The princess kissed the frog, **so** he turned into a prince.

*A comma must come before the conjunction!*

'as a...'

'like a ...'

**Similes** contain '**as** a...' or '**like** a...'. They compare one thing to another.

The flames were **as fierce as** a tiger hunting for its prey.

The exploding bomb was **like** a bubbling volcano.

### What! Sentences

Exclamatory sentence starting with the word **what** or **how**.

**What** big eyes you have!

**What** a good answer!

**How** lucky we are!
