

English:

We will be exploring Shakespeare's plays, a Midsummer Night's Dream and Macbeth. We will look at different versions of these to understand the stories and the different types of play that Shakespeare wrote.

We will continue to revise our grammar skills and knowledge from earlier in the year.

Maths:

We will continue to revise and consolidate our understanding of our maths learning so far.

As part of this, we will work on projects exploring the maths needed to plan a holiday and the maths needed for personal finance in adulthood.

Topic:

This half term we will look at entertainment. A big part of this will be putting on our year 5/6 performance, but we will also explore the history of the theatre and the works of Shakespeare.

French:

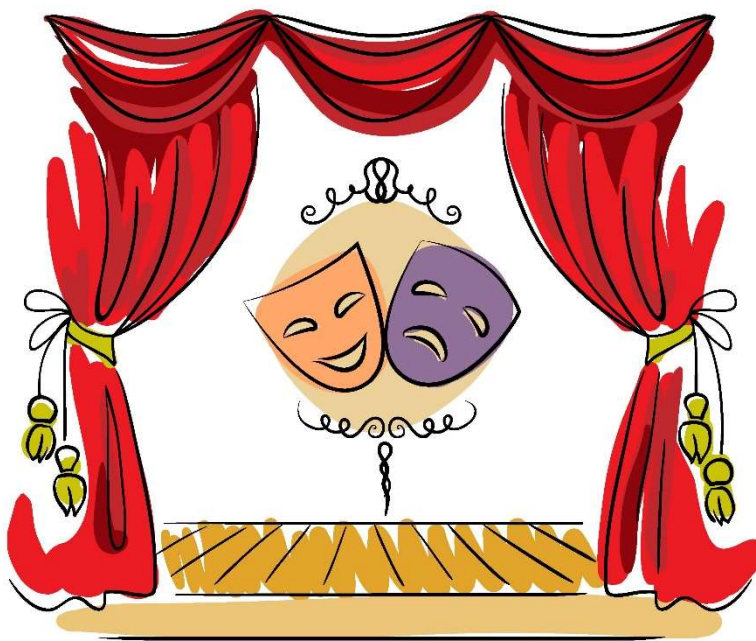
We will learn about how to talk about holidays.

PE:

Monday: Rounders

Reading:

We will revise all of our DERIC skills, particularly focussing on how to use evidence from the text to support our explanations.

**DT:**

We will be thinking about sustainability in salad design and creation, as well as budgeting for the ingredients needed to make these.

Science:

This term we will be learning about the circulatory system. We will compare the function of this to other body systems, and look at the roles of the hearts, blood vessels and blood cells. We will then investigate the impact of exercise on our circulatory system.

Music:

We will work on songs for our show and explore digital music creation.

RE:

What is holiness for Jewish people: a place, a time, an object, or something else?

We will explore the meaning of 'holiness' and look at the idea in different contexts within Judaism.

Computing:

We will bring our coding learning together by applying it to the programming of Micro:Bits using a new coding platform (MakeCode). We will programme these to do different things, supported by a team from ARM, who will also help us learn more about how these skills are used in the workplace.
