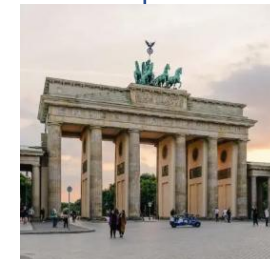

	Compass	A tool for finding your way around with a needle that always points to the north		Map Symbol	Small pictures that stand for different features on a map
	physical features	The natural world, for example - mountains, rivers, seas and forests.		human features	Things that have been made by humans e.g. roads, buildings and bridges
	Cardinal Points	The main compass points: North, South, East West		Map Atlas	Map - an image representing a place Atlas - A book full of maps and information about the world
	Globe	A 3D model of the earth, shaped like a sphere Labelled with the equator to divide North and Southern hemispheres		climate	What the weather is like over many years. Climate zones - areas of the world with similar climates
	Europe	A continent between Asia and the Atlantic Ocean		landmark	Something that is easy to see and can help a person find the way to a place nearby
