









Royal Family	The Royal Family is the immediate family of kings and queens and sometimes their extended family.
King Charles III	King Charles III was crowned King in May 2023.
Queen Elizabeth II	Queen Elizabeth II was born in 21 st April 1926 and died on September 2022. She was Queen for 70 years.
A monarch	I can understand that we have a King that rules us and that Britain has had a king or queen for many years.
Succession	To know who will succeed the King and how succession works. King Charles has two children. Prince William will be the next king.
Coronation	To understand that the Coronation of King Charles III is an historical event.
