



Admission to the Nursery Class at Cherry Hinton Church of England Primary School

Parents wishing to apply for a nursery place for their child should contact the school for information on admission. Children can join the nursery in the term after their 3rd birthday and places are allocated on the basis of the intake limit.

All 3 and 4 year olds have access to the 'universal entitlement' of 15 free hours of nursery education. Working parents of 3 and 4 year olds may also have access to the 'extended' entitlement of 30 free hours of nursery education. Admissions to Cherry Hinton Church of England Primary School are organised by the Local Authority Admissions Officers.

If children are 4 on 31st August they may start school at the beginning of the Autumn Term.

New Reception Children

During the Summer term we organise drop-ins and a meeting for new parents so that you and your child can find out about our school. The Foundation Stage teacher will also try to visit your child in their nursery setting where practicable and will offer a home visit in September. We have a staggered entry over an initial three week period to allow the children sufficient time to settle in and by the fourth week it is hoped that all the children will be in full-time. We will however consult with parents over what is best for their child.
